Biological nature of man determines the limits of our individual and unrepeatable existence in 'space-time', shut away and not accessible to all things and people from the outside world. These impenetrable parallel entities make us live in isolation and incomprehension. A set of "one-man worlds" - each being different from ours because of, for example, cultural or social diversity-consolidates complicated and complex relationship between man and his environment. The term "parallel worlds" was coined for the need of quantum physics, however, when used as a poetic metaphor perfectly illustrates the state of being different worlds is the opportunity to meet, to overcome prejudices and to temper antagonisms. Art as a communication tool allows to express experiences, needs, thoughts and emotions. It helps self- identification and better recognition of oneself and those who are different, strange and unknown. In the space of art, "parallel worlds" have a good chance of linear meeting on the horizon drawn by aesthetic values.

The organisers of the conference hope that the content of lectures and reflection will allow to look at art as an integrating frame of reference, satisfying the need for contact with the world as a whole.
